PRO-PALESTINIAN PROTEST - On Sunday, May 17, 2009, Sgt. Det. Brian McMasters and Det. William Dickinson monitored a protest organized by [REDACTED] outside the Westin Copley Place Hotel from about 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.. The pro-Palestinian Protest targeted the annual dinner sponsored by the [REDACTED]. The dinner was attended by approximately 700 persons. About 45-50 protestors demonstrated on the sidewalk outside the hotel causing some traffic delays and sometimes blocking pedestrian passage on the sidewalk. Uniformed officers had to repeatedly move protestors along. Three women believed to be associated with Code Pink were prevented from getting into the dinner by private security at the event.
