The POTUS, Barrack Obama, will be in Boston on Thursday April 1, 2010 to attend a fundraising reception and dinner at 60 State St. that is scheduled to run from 4:30 pm - 7:30 pm. Local activist groups are already in the process of planning to protest at this event and are referring to it as a "golden opportunity to have a massive demo to demand: bring our troops and war money home, fund national healthcare not international warfare, jobs not drones, money for education not occupation (pro-Palestine / Gaza).....etc". So far this action has been endorsed by United for Peace with Justice, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], Code Pink, and [REDACTED].

The above activist groups also mention that there will most likely a large turnout from the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also protesting at this event and are advising the members of their individual groups to "be there in strength" to shout down the [REDACTED] activists. The [REDACTED]s against national healthcare and believes that taxes are high enough already and should be reduced. Depending how the vote on healthcare goes, the [REDACTED] could muster a large turnout of activists and confrontations between the two groups of activists are possible.

April 1st is also dubbed by environmental activists, in particular the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] as "Fossil Fuel's Day 2010" and protests targeting those who invest in or fund the fossil fuel industry are planned to take place city-wide on this date. In the past, these activists have conducted direct actions that ranged from the use of "sleeping dragons" to "banner drops". There's a strong likelihood that members of these two groups will also be present at the planned 60 State St protest.
