On Thursday, March 29, 2007 at about 8:00 pm, Detective Creed and Trooper Favale of the BRIC, arrested [REDACTED] District Ct. arrest warrant for unarmed robbery and A&BD/W shod foot ([REDACTED] [REDACTED]) that was issued for an incident which occurred on March 17, 2007 on Area D-14. O'Brien was arrested at [REDACTED] in Jamiaca Plain [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

[REDACTED], who is well known to officers, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED], Code Pink (anti-war / abortion rights group, associate), [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]). [REDACTED] has been arrested at past demonstrations. Currently [REDACTED] is an organizer for the [REDACTED]

After [REDACTED] was interviewed by Detective Foley (D-14) and Detective Mackey (SAU), at about 10:05 pm, I interviewed [REDACTED] regarding the upcoming [REDACTED]. Detective Foley also sat in on the interview.

[REDACTED] stated that the [REDACTED] and "[REDACTED]" (the planned actions against the conference) have not been discussed at any [REDACTED], however he did admit that the [REDACTED] is involved in opposing the Boston University Bio-Defense Lab. The Bio-Defense Lab is scheduled to be targeted by activists during Bio-Justice 2007. [REDACTED] was asked if he still associates with the [REDACTED] and he stated that he is now associating more with the ISO rather than local anarchist groups. He further stated that the [REDACTED] has recently been inactive (since [REDACTED] and that most of [REDACTED] members are now associated with [REDACTED]. It should be noted that traditionally the anarchists and socialists do not see eye to eye on most issues.

When observed at past demonstrations, [REDACTED] was usually been acting as an instigator attempting to "fire up" the crowd. [REDACTED] membership in the [REDACTED] may be a sign that the group will be becoming more active in the future. At the [REDACTED] anti-war rally, the was able to draw between 30-40 activists.
